ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible you must have graduated, or be in the final year leading towards graduation, from a Northwest Territories high school, with a minimum of 4 years of formal schooling in the Northwest Territories. High school equivalency earned in the Northwest Territories is accepted.

Scholarships will only be released to students upon evidence of registration in an accredited post-secondary institution. The Scholarship can be awarded to the same recipient a maximum of 2 times.

APPLICATION

Applications must be received by May 10th

The application must include the application form and on separate sheets of paper, provide the following support material:

Statement of Interest - The Statement of interest should include your reasons for pursuing an architectural education, a description of the people (architects, artists, writers, thinkers...) and/or work that you admire, and your academic goals. Your statement should be 300-500 words (double spaced) in length. Be sure to include your name at the top of your statement.

Letter of Acceptance - from a university or technical school

Portfolio - The portfolio should include graphic material that best illustrates your creative ability. The format may be original material in maximum A3 (11x17) format or digital copy, PDF Format, on USB or by hyperlink to a

shared website. All materials should be labelled with your name.

Letter of Recommendation - If you are just graduating from High School provide a letter of recommendation from a current or past teacher/instructor familiar with your academic achievements and career aspirations.

DEADLINE

Submissions must be received before 5:00 PM on May 10, 2024 to the NWTAA Office. Applications postmarked, delivered or emailed after this time and date will not be considered. Architecture is not simply a question of proportion, beauty and technical competence, but rather, the establishment of a direct connection with the human heart.
